GENERAL RULES:

1. All entrants are required to have a current, paid AQHA membership. Any membership may be obtained in the show office for an additional fee.
2. AMATEUR/NOVICE AMATEUR: Every rider competing in an Amateur or Novice Amateur class must possess a current Amateur card issued by AQHA. This card/photocopy must be shown to the show secretary prior to competing. See current AQHA handbook for ownership requirements.
3. YOUTH/NOVICE YOUTH: must be members of AQHYA. Membership cards must be shown to the show secretary prior to competing. See current AQHA handbook for ownership requirements.
4. AQHA rules and only AQHA rules will prevail in all classes as set forth in the official 2008 AQHA handbook.
5. REGISTRATION papers must be presented to the show secretary upon arrival. Original of old papers or photostats of new papers on Youth and Amateur events must be shown.
6. REFUND OF ENTRY with veterinarian certificate before the show starts.
7. NO RESERVATIONS FOR STALLS WITHOUT FEES. STALLS WILL BE ISSUED ON A FIRST PAID BASIS. NO REFUNDS UNLESS VET CERTIFICATE – THEN \$15.00 OFFICE FEE PER STALL WILL BE ASSESSED.
8. If early arrival, and you chose your own stall, the show management reserves the right to re-locate based on the show secretaries master stall chart.
9. If all bills are not paid by the end of the circuit, show management will have no other choice but to take action with AQHA. A \$25.00 NSF fee will be charged for all returned checks. No post-dated checks will be accepted.
- 10. All exhibitors are responsible for fines levied against the show caused by the exhibitors.**
11. Awards will be given to 6 places.
12. Lead Line and Walk Trot not allowed to cross entry with any other three gaited class.
13. For Performance Halter: Horse must have earned a Performance ROM in that division. Please bring proof of ROM.
