Enter each horse in at least one class by phone or mail no later than April 10 to avoid the \$5.00 post entry charge.

1. AQHA rules will prevail in all classes as set forth in the 2008 AQHA rule book.
2. Registration papers copy of must be presented to the show Secretary upon arrival. Proof of ROM required for performance halter classes. *Refer to AQHA Handbook for Performance Halter Horse rules*
3. Current AQHA amateur card must be presented to the Secretary in order to enter any amateur event.
4. Novice Classes: Available to an amateur or youth rider who has not accumulated a total of 10 or more performance points in the AQHA Open, Amateur, or Youth Divisions combined. Every person competing in a Novice class must possess a Novice card. For additional rules see current AQHA rule book.
5. All classes must be entered at the office one class prior to entered class. **REFUND OF ENTRY FEE ON A VETERINARIAN'S CERTIFICATE ONLY IF RECEIVED BEFORE THE SHOW ENDS.**
6. **KNOW THIS RULE:** All exhibitors are responsible for fines levied against the show caused by the exhibitors. Refer to current AQHA Handbook.
7. **STALLS - Space is limited, reserve ASAP.** Please indicate if stalls are for stallions.
Mail your stall request and payment to: SEWSC Stalls, Barbara Williams, P.O. Box 3013 Hayden Lake, ID 83835. A stall request / entry form attached. After April 1, no stall refund will be made without a veterinarian's certificate. Portable stalls will be utilized for overflow.
NOTE TO TRAINERS: PLEASE LIST ALL OF YOUR CLIENTS; otherwise no guarantee will be made as to stabling arrangements.
8. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry of any exhibitor who has shown objectionable behavior at the show or to its management.
9. Awards for first place through sixth place will be given in all classes. Hi-Point awards will be given in all halter divisions. Circuit All-Around Awards will be awarded in Jr Horse, Sr Horse, Amateur, Novice Amateur, Amateur Select, Walk/Trot 10 and under, Youth 13 & under, Youth 14 – 18 and Novice Youth, however, horses must be exhibited to all 4 judges in 3 AQHA categories to be eligible to receive the Circuit All-Around Award. Refer to list of Categories posted in show office or AQHA handbook. Halter is a category. Walk/Trot 10 and under exhibitors points will be accumulated and computed only in the 10 & under Walk/Trot classes. Points will be computed using the following point system: Points will be counted 9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1 plus AQHA points earned. If fewer than 9 horses are placed in a class (i.e. if 5 horses are placed), points will be counted 5-4-3-2-1 plus AQHA points earned. Disqualified horses will not earn points. Ties will be broken by: 1. the horse earning the greatest credits in the greatest number of events, 2. the horse or contestant winning over the greatest number of horses, 3. Earned the most credits in performance events. Green Horse classes will not count towards the Circuit All-Around Award. The High Point and Circuit All-Around awards are to be given upon completion of the Southeastern Washington Show Circuit. The award will be based upon the results of competitions on all days. **CONTESTANTS MUST SIGN UP PRIOR TO ENTERING THE SHOW RING TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR ALL-AROUND AWARDS WITH THE EXCEPTION OF HALTER CLASSES.**
10. Reserve your cattle for all roping events by Monday, March 31, 2008 and for the cow events by Thursday, April 10th by 9:00PM, by calling Barbara Williams (208)683-1617 or Jerry Failing (509) 301-9471. The draw for the working order will be made on the closing date. Late entries and post entries will be accepted if cattle are available.
11. **ABSOLUTELY NO POST-DATED CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** If all bills are not paid by the end of the circuit, show management will have no other choice but to take action with AQHA. A \$50.00 NSF fee will be charged for all returned checks.
12. Jackpots will be paid through points (i.e. 5 horses-60/40 split, 10 horses-50/30/20 split, 15 horses-40/30/20/10 split)
13. For equestrians with disabilities classes, refer to current AQHA Handbook.
14. To compete for added monies, exhibitors must show under all 4 judges.
15. Added monies will be split according to NRCHA rules. Refer to rule book or see show secretary.
16. 10 and under walk/trot exhibitors are allowed to cross enter.

All stalls on a **FIRST PAID BASIS** due to limited number of premium stalls. Postmark to determine date paid. Stall request for horses to be stabled together should be submitted together; otherwise the postmark of the last request received will be used.
